- 1. Entries must be fully and correctly completed and properly signed.
- 2. The correct entrance fee MUST accompany each entry unless it is to be billed to a Board of Education.
- 3. Late fee of \$15.00 will be charged after to applications received after February 9th.
- 4. Unless a school board will accept a billing from the Music Festival, a cheque must be enclosed. Your cancelled cheque will be your receipt.
- 5. Entry fees cannot be refunded, except under exceptional circumstances where the entry is rejected by the Board of Directors.
- 6. Competitors are completely responsible for entering the correct class(es). Please read the "Rules & Regulations" of the festival, in particular sections 2.1 and 2.2.
- 7. ENTRIES CLOSE January 26, 2024 NO EXCEPTIONS OR EXTENSIONS.
- 8. There will be no class changes after programming is completed. The only exception to this is a cancellation, in which case the Festival Secretary should be notified in advance of the festival.
- 9. Please provide an original copy of music to the Hall Secretary prior to performance time if class is "Competitor's Own Choice."
- 10. "COPYRIGHT" NO ONE IS ALLOWED TO COPY WORK IN WHICH COPYRIGHT EXISTS WITHOUT FIRST OBTAINING WRITTEN PERMISSION FROM THE COPYRIGHT OWNERS. THIS IS THE LAW AND IT APPLIES TO OUR FESTIVAL AND ALL OUR COMPETITORS. The use of photocopied music is NOT permitted, this applies to accompanists also.
- 11. If a competitor is late and the others have arrived on time, the latecomer will be allowed to perform at the end of the class at the adjudicator's discretion and if time permits.
- 12. The Peterborough Kiwanis Music Festival, its staff and volunteers, assumes no responsibility for the actions or behaviour of any participant, teacher or supervisor participating in the events sponsored by the festival, or those of any person attending such events.

Permission for publication of competitor's names and indication that press coverage will take place through the local newspaper.

While it is the policy of the Peterborough Kiwanis Music Festival that Festival performances and adjudications should not be recorded in any way, the realities of modern technology make it impossible to fully monitor and enforce this policy.

We ask the following from our spectators:

- 1. No recording of any kind is permitted of adjudications.
- Guests should position themselves 15 feet behind the adjudicator for all recordings, minimizing distraction or disruption.
- Determination of what constitutes "disruption" is at the sole discretion of the festival personnel at each event.

All festival entrants should note this policy, and with their entry, acknowledge and agree that their performance might be recorded by any guest under the conditions stated.
